



Congratulations on your new Garage Floor By Garage Innovations, Inc.

Cleaning & Maintenance:

- ❖ **Most dirt can be washed off the floor using a garden hose with pressure and a squeegee.**
- ❖ **For stubborn stains use a mild detergent. Most tire marks can be cleaned with a citrus type cleaner. We recommend Zep Commercial Heavy Duty Citrus Degreaser. You can find it at Lowes. Item# 369895.**
- ❖ **For spills simply use a soft towel to wipe up any oil, grease, gas, transmission fluid, antifreeze and other chemical as soon as possible. Any remaining residue can be cleaned with a mild detergent.**

Preventative Maintenance:

- ❖ **To ensure non-slip characteristics, broom out snow and ice after falls off the car. Chances are there is salt, sand and other deicing road debris mixed in.**

Drying Times:

- ❖ **Light Foot Traffic – coating will dry for light foot traffic in 12 to 16 hours.**
- ❖ **Normal Foot Traffic – coating will dry for normal foot traffic in 24 hours. At 24 hours you can move your items back into the garage or interior room and place them on the floor. Avoid dragging items across the floor until the coating is fully cured (5-7 days).**
- ❖ **Vehicle Traffic – allow 72 hours after the clear coat has been applied to drive your car onto the floor.**

NOTE: These times are at 70°F and 50% relative humidity – lower temperatures or high humidity will require additional time.
